

CORE GRAPHS AND HANNA NEUMANN'S CONJECTURE

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Abstract

We use the concept of core graphs $\Gamma^*(H)$ of subgroups *H* of free groups *F* generated by the set $X = \{a, b\}$, in order to show that if $\Gamma^*(H)$ and $\Gamma^*(K)$ are core graphs of two finitely generated subgroups *H* and *K* of a free group *F* generated by the set $X = \{a, b\}$, then the Hanna Neumann's conjecture holds, that by using the concept of the type of compatible branch points.
